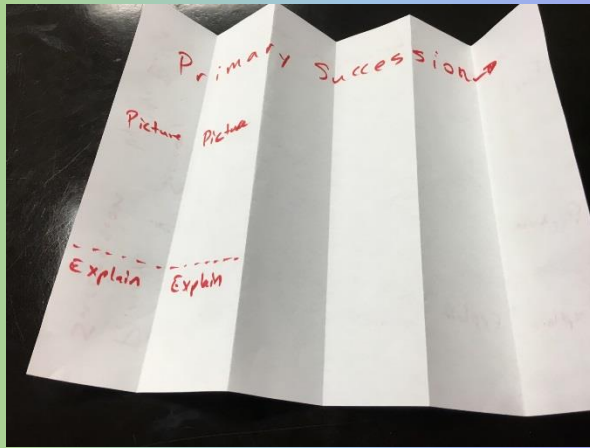
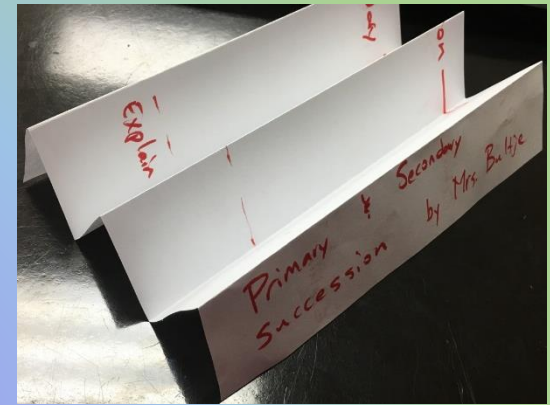


# SUCCESSION FOLDABLE

Fold your paper in half (hamburger style)

Then fold each half into thirds, so that your paper looks like the picture on the top right. The first page is the title page (as shown in the picture on the top right). The title is: Primary & Secondary Succession



Open up your paper and turn it to the side that does not contain the title page. Find a google image of "primary succession" draw and explain (look at the picture on the left) six stages of primary succession in the six boxes created by your folds.

Include the following vocabulary in your explanation: climax community, pioneer organisms, grasses, trees, lichens, shrubs, rocks

Once you have a stable community (the end of primary succession) a fire destroys your forest (flip over your paper and show this on the first fold, as shown in the picture on the bottom right). Take your community through the stages of secondary succession (google image "secondary succession" to find a picture. In secondary succession include climax community, pioneer organisms, and the necessary organisms.
